## Use of Linden Shore District Beaches and Shorefront

### RULES & REGULATIONS

**GENERAL CONDUCT:** You are hereby asked to refrain from any activities which can be disturbing and disruptive to others.

**BEACH PARTIES:** No beach parties may be held on District Property without the permission of one of the Officers of the Linden Shore District. In addition, no beach parties may be held without at least one adult, (21 years or older), family member of the District present while the party is in occurring. Furthermore, such member or members will be responsible for the general conduct of the gathering. Parties must end by no later than 10:30pm unless otherwise approved by an Officer of the Linden Shore District prior to the date of the event.

**DOGS:** Dogs are not allowed on Beaches when Beaches are occupied. Dogs are to be “leashed” per Town of Branford Ordinance. **PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR PET!**

**LITTER:** Glass containers of any type are not allowed on the Beaches. All litter should be placed in trash receptacles which are provided in key areas at Linden Shore stairway, Montgomery Parkway grove and Pebbly Beach.

**FIRES:** Bon fires are not permitted on Linden Shore District Property.

**ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES:** The use of Alcoholic Beverages is governed by Connecticut State Statutes on Linden Shore District Property.

**DESIGNATED SWIMMING AREAS:** No water craft are permitted within the designated swimming areas as outlined by the orange buoys. No “oars” or “Kayak Paddles” are permitted in the designated swimming area. No fishing is allowed in the designated swimming areas.

**SMALL BOATS**: Only small boats, canoes and kayaks that are registered yearly with the Linden Shore District, are permitted to be stored in designated storage racks on Linden Shore District Property or boat stakes. Once your yearly registration fee is paid, a decal or decals will be provided to you to be clearly displayed on each vessel. Please refer to “lindenshoredistrict.com” for registration information.

**GENERAL SAFETY**: When using the rafts, diving boards and seawalls, we require that you refrain from behavior that will jeopardize your safety or any other members and their guests as well as the Linden Shore District insurance policy. Some examples of “unsafe” behavior are, but not limited to, pushing, king or queen of the raft, sinking the corner of the rafts, diving or jumping off the seawalls and general rough-housing. This behavior could cause serious injuries and could also jeopardize the Linden Shore District insurance coverage.

**PLEASE NOTE**: PARENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ACTIONS AND BEHAVIOR OF ALL MINORS AND GUESTS.

Your cooperation is requested in helping to observe and follow all the rules and regulations of the Linden Shore District for the best interest of you, your family, neighbors and guests in helping to keep the Linden Shore District property cleaner, safer and pleasant for small children and adults alike. **PLEASE NOTE**: ALL HOMEOWNERS WHO RENT THEIR PROPERTY ARE REQUESTED TO POST THE RULES AND REGULATION FOR YOUR RENTERS.
